

G.I. War Menu: Turkey For All, Sooner or Later

SAIGON, South Vietnam, Nov. 23 (AP)—Most American servicemen in Vietnam will have Thanksgiving dinners tomorrow starting off with shrimp cocktail and going on through turkey and giblet gravy, dressing, candied sweet potatoes, mixed vegetables and cranberry sauce.

While there is turkey for all, some men on long-range patrols or on isolated outpost duty will have to wait awhile. They can expect to dine on C rations.

For the 62,000 United States Marines in the northern part of the country, the preparations included 25 tons of turkey and 10 tons of ham.

The special menu also will be served to the 60,000 Americans serving in the 7th Fleet.

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
