President Issues Order Putting Attorney General in Charge

WASHINGTON, Jan. 14—President Roosevelt issued a proclamation today ordering registration of all alien enemies in the United States, Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands. The proclamation applies to "all natives, denizens or subjects" over 13 years of age of any nation or government at war with the United States.

The President acted under a law which authorizes him, in wartime, to declare liable to be "apprehended, restrained, secured and removed" all enemy aliens.

The Attorney General was authorized to set dates for the registration and to take such steps as he deemed necessary to make certain that all enemy aliens carry identification cards.
