MARION, Ala., Sept. 29 (UPI)—A Perry County grand jury refused yesterday to indict a state trooper named in the death of a Negro, Jimmie Lee Jackson, who was shot in February.

Circuit Solicitor Blanchard McLeod said the murder charge was one of 41 which the allwhite panel spent more than a day considering.

Mr. McLeod identified the man against whom he sought the indictment as "a "trooper Fowler."

Mr. Jackson, 26, was fatally wounded in Marion on the night of Feb. 18 when whites, Negroes and troopers clashed in the streets.
