

Disturbance by Teen-Agers Is Reported in Hollywood

HOLLYWOOD, Nov. 12 (UPI)—More than 1,500 teen-agers reportedly took over part of the Sunset Strip area here tonight by stoning police and burning a rapid transit bus.

The police said that the mob, armed with molotov cocktails, walked the streets and stopped two buses. They allegedly started a fire in one of the buses, which was quickly extinguished, the police said.

Several teen-agers were injured and taken to nearby hospitals.

The disturbance started as part of a planned rally with a mass meeting at a local coffee house. For the last two days handbills had been circulated advertising the rally in protest of treatment by police of teen-agers.
